

Gliderol TM305C Coding Instructions

Each standard receiver can be configured to accept codes from ten separate handset units



- 1) Carefully remove the light cover by pulling down on tab near front of unit
- 2) Press the learn button once (located on receiver board as shown)
- A red light will illuminate



- 3) Press large button on the handset once and hold until redlight on receiver board turns off
- This confirms that the handset is programmed (Always use the large button for coding, even if configured to use small buttons for normal operation)



Note: To reset the receiver press and hold the learn button (2.) for 12 seconds. This will erase all handsets from the memory. This is recommended if a remote has been lost or stolen. Any other handsets previously used will need to be reprogrammed by following steps 1, 2 and 3 above.
